### Illness

Please can you keep your child at home if he / she is generally unwell to prevent staff and other children becoming ill (cough, sore throat, high temperature, infection or illness). Please also inform the Pre-School as to the nature of the infection / illness so that we can alert other parents / carers if necessary.

Parents / carers are also reminded not to bring a child into Pre-School who has been vomiting or had diarrhoea until **48 hours** has elapsed since the last attack.

You are also required to keep your child at home for **48 hours** from the start of taking antibiotics or other medication (even if they have had it before).

Please would you be kind enough to phone the Pre-School on 07742 228077 to let us know if your child is not coming in as their place can then be offered as a pay and play place.



### Suitable Clothing

Now that the weather is turning, please can you ensure that children have named warmed clothing, named waterproof coats and named wellies at the Pre-School each day. As part of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum, children must have the opportunity to play outside whatever the weather.

Please can you also ensure that you take items of clothing / wellies home at the end of the session.



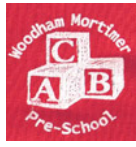
### Car Park Barriers
