Preparing for cold/wet weather

At Pre-School we like to get the children playing outside as much as possible. To enable us to do this please remember to send you child into preschool with a pair of labelled wellies to be stored in our 'Wellie Station'. Please do not send them in in plastic bags (Woodham Mortimer Pre-School wellies bags can be purchased if you wish).

Please could you also ensure your child's preschool bag contains a complete change of clothes? If your child happens to have an allin-one suit, it would be useful to send this with them to preschool too. Thank you.

Reminders

Sickness: If your child has sickness or diarrhea please keep them away from preschool for **48 hours** after the last episode and inform Pre-School.

Medication:

- If your child is on long-term medication please ensure this is at Pre-School every time your child is otherwise your child may not be able to stay at Pre-School that day. Please also check you have filled out a health care plan with details of how the medicine is administered.
- If your child has been prescribed medication for a short period of time they need to have been taking it for 48 hours before coming back to Pre-School.

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Lunches: Please remember we are a 'nut free' Pre-School and to slice grapes and sausages lengthways when preparing lunch for your child to avoid any choking hazards. Shoes: To encourage your child to become more independent in preparation for going to school, please can you provide them with shoes they can put on and take off themselves (slip-on or Velcro).

Labelling: Can you please ensure that all items your child brings to preschool are named (e.g. clothes, lunch boxes, drinking bottles)? We are encouraging the children to read their name in different contexts. Car Park: Please use the car park (through the gate) at all times (unless full). If the gate is closed please open and attach the hook safely on the back of the gate to the fence. Equipment donations: Donations of any IT equipment (Leap pads, Ipads, etc) would be gratefully received. Please speak to Nikki if you have something that may be of use to the Pre-School.
