Inside the house are a large range of objects to promote the children's independence and thinking skills. They are encouraged to use their imaginations, work together and develop problem solving skills.

It has been a brilliant success and the children have shown some amazing skills in planning and using their ideas to create things such as dens, garages, obstacle courses and vehicles, it has been lovely to see them working together on large scale projects so cooperatively.

### The New Fence

As you may have seen we now have a new temporary fence up around the outside play area. Although we have put up the fencing for added safety the children will still have our wonderful field to play on. We know the field is a great asset to us and the enjoyment the children get from it, now we can always be certain that they are adequately and safely supervised at all times.

### Change of Departure

We will be trialling a change to the end of session pick up on a Tuesday and Thursday PM sessions. This will help them in their preparation for going to school and alleviate the congestion at the end of session. Parents are more than welcome to discuss anything with staff when they drop off in the morning or arrange a convenient time to have a chat.
